Men's 4-Ball Championship



Starting Time:	Players should report to their starting hole, 5 minutes prior to the tee off time. Groups and starting times will not be delayed. Players late for play will be penalized or disqualified based on the ruling of the tournament committee.
Tournament Format:	36-hole Better Ball Medal play. No Handicap
Flights:	Flights determined by Saturday Scores. 6-10 groups per flight. Teams may choose to play up in championship bracket.
Overall Winner:	Overall Winner can come from any flight
Scorecards:	Each team will have 1 official scorecard. Teams will switch cards on the tee and be responsible for the accurate scoring of the twosome they are playing with. Both teams need to verify and attest the team scores prior to turning in the card at the scoring table.
Lateral Hazards:	Long grass and wooded areas, not marked by OB stakes, are considered penalty areas. The long grass / wood line defines the lateral hazard. Red stakes are for a visual reminder that the area is a hazard.
Tees:	Saturday: All players – White/Blue Sunday: All players – White/Blue
Discontinuance of Play:	Play will be discontinued if there is a danger of lightning or if the course is deemed unplayable by the tournament committee. If a player believes there is a danger of lightning, he may discontinue play before the committee suspends play. Bad weather is not of itself a reason for discontinuing play. 1 long blast from horn – Discontinue play and find shelter. Mark ball prior top picking it up. 3 short blasts from horn – Continue with play.
Equipment:	14 Club Limit (USGA List of Conforming Clubs), Distance measuring allowed including those that measure gradient. One ball rule NOT in effect.
Summer Rules:	Summer Rules in effect unless allowed within the rules of golf.
Additional 2020 Updates:	Carts are 2-Rider Carts, no individual carts. Pins can come out. Bunkers – Play it as it lies. Rake when done.
Embedded Ball:	Embedded ball rule in effect Rule 25-2. Through the Green (not hazards), Ball may be lift, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the original position, no nearer the hole.
Local Rule E-5:	NOT IN PLAY. (OB and lost ball option)
